What is Running Start?

Running Start is a 6-week-long summer bridge program for local high school students who are graduating. This program assists students in creating a smooth transition into college life at Santa Barbara City College.

What does the program provide?

Running Start provides students with the opportunity to get a head start in college. Students will engage in taking college-level courses and be provided with academic support during the SBCC summer session. Additionally, students who participate in the program will receive \$\$ each week upon completion of program requirements, as well as go on field trips. It is a great way to make new friends and network.

6-Week Program (June 17th-July 25th)

PD 100-College Success (3 Units)

Students clarify their educational objectives and develop the skills necessary to reach them. Topics include time management, reading and study skills, goal-setting, career planning, and communications skills.

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CHST 101- Mexican-American (Chicano)History In The U.S. (3 Units)

Examines the role of the Mexican-Americans and other Latinos/as in U.S. history. Attention is given to the economic, social, political, and cultural experiences of Mexican-Americans.
